Dear Honorable Chairs and Members of the Joint Committee on the Judiciary,

Thank you for hearing H1167, An Act to improve public safety by facilitating access to addiction services before your committee on October 14th.

This bill would require that at intake, an individual entering either a jail or prison would receive an evaluation to determine a potential history of substance abuse. Treatment would then be offered through a variety of sources including volunteers from community recovery programs. Many who enter the prison system have a history of substance abuse that may be the root cause of their illicit activity that resulted in their confinement. Treating that addiction is a step towards rehabilitating that person.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this bill. I respectfully request that *H1167*, *An Act to improve public safety by facilitating access to addiction services* be released favorably and expeditiously from your committee.
