Dear Honorable Chairs and Members of the Joint Committee on the Judiciary,

Thank you for hearing H1433, An Act Relative to Expungement of Criminal or Juvenile Records for Individuals Who Committed Offenses as Children or Young Adults before your committee on September 16th.

This bill would allow anyone at any age who has a conviction or adjudication in Massachusetts prior to the age of 21 may have their criminal and court records expunged. If there was a sentence or disposition attached that must be completed prior to the expungement. Having a record is a significant barrier to employment. This bill is an opportunity for a person who committed an offense as a youth and has completed their punishment to have a clean slate.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this bill. I respectfully request that H1433, An Act Relative to Expungement of Criminal or Juvenile Records for Individuals Who Committed Offenses as Children or Young Adults be released favorably and expeditiously from your committee.
