Dear Honorable Chairs and Members of the Joint Committee on Financial Services,

Thank you for hearing H1728, An Act prohibiting the bullying of public employees before your committee today.

This bill would make bullying a public employee illegal. Additionally, it would require workplaces to respond and work to remedy accusations of bullying. Workplaces would be held liable by the courts if they were found to be in violation. Victims could be compensated with reinstatement, reassignment, and removal of the offending party from the complainant's work environment, back pay, front pay, damages, and attorney's fees.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this bill. I respectfully request that H1728, An Act prohibiting the bullying of public employees be released favorably and expeditiously from your committee.
