Dear Chairman Dempsey and Members of the House Committee on Ways and Means,

I implore you to favorably release S2119, An Act to establish Pay Equity so that the House may pass this bill and move it towards Governor Baker's desk. The bill was passed unanimously by the Senate in late January.

In the Commonwealth, women make up approximately half the workforce but make approximately 18% less than their male counterparts. This is unacceptable anywhere but particularly in the Commonwealth where we pride ourselves on equality. The bill seeks to level the playing field between men and women by defining comparable work, banning the practice of asking for prior pay history during the hiring process, and by forbidding the termination of an employee if he or she discloses their pay to co-workers or colleagues. This bill would benefit every citizen in the Commonwealth
