Dear Honorable Chairs and Members of the Joint Committee on Public Service,

Thank you for hearing H2319, An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts before your committee on June 2^{nd} .

This bill would affirm that custodian, maintenance, and other non-teaching positions be treated as civil service positions or union positions and subject to those processes for hiring, promotion, and termination of those positions. In some instances, when a school superintendent or principal changes these employees, because they lack protection, are wrongfully treated to serve a political agenda. These employees have no bearing on a student's test scores and should not be a political football if a district choses to pursue a different direction academically.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this bill. I respectfully request that *H2319*, *An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts* be released favorably and expeditiously from your committee.
